


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
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Getting started

Once you log in with your registered email and password, you will have access to your dashboard, **where it all begins**.


Student

-  **Dashboard** Your home page. Here you can find the overview of the courses you are enrolled into.
-  **Profile** Your personal student profile page, where you can visualize your achievements (e.g., points, badges and ranks).
-  **My Courses** Where you can access all your courses.
-  **My Account** Where you can change your account details (e.g., name, surname, email, and password)
-  **Logout** To log out of the platform.
-  Select your language. The platform is available in English, Greek, Italian, Polish, Portuguese, Romanian and Spanish.

In the Profile page, you can find an overview of your **progress** and **achievements** for each course you are enrolled into.

Your Courses



- the number of lessons and assignments you completed (D);
- the button to access the course (E).



Your learning journey at a glance


After clicking on “Go to Course”, you'll be directed to the course page. As shown in the image below, on this screen, you can notice on the top left the name of the course and the teacher, while, on the right, the number of points you earned and your position in the course's leaderboard. In the middle of your screen, there are all the course's chapters, which will have a coloured tick if the lesson or assignment has been completed or a grey tick if it has not been completed yet.

Lessons and assignments

Scrolling down on the course page, you will find the repository of the course materials, along with the lessons and assignments in your course divided by chapter. Teachers can add different types of lessons: video lessons, quizzes, practice tests or other external resources or content, recognizable by their different icons.

Repository

Clicking on "View Repository", you will be redirected to a new page where you will find the files made available by the teachers or other students, as well as upload your content (if enabled by the teacher). You can see the document's owner, the title, the points required to download it, and an "Options" button showing all the details.
